



St Dominic's Day Liturgy

Last Friday was had a liturgy for St Dominic's Day.

Prouille is founded on the works of the Dominican Nuns. As a result, the Feast Day of St Dominic is important to the school community. Prouille was chosen as the name of the school, for it was at Prouille in France, in the year 1206, that St Dominic beheld a vision of Our Blessed Lady in which she instructed him to found his Order of Nuns at St Mary's Prouille. In Prouille, then, St Dominic's spiritual ideal took form and from Prouille was launched his world-wide enterprise for the conquest of souls. The name "Prouille" signifies that in Wahroonga the Dominican system of Christian education was established and maintained.

Our Years 5 and 6 students travelled to Bathurst on Thursday and Friday for an overnight history excursion.

Their itinerary included visiting the gold fields and panning for gold, experiencing the hardship of the early gold miners by making mud bricks, playing basic games (such as tug-of-war) and making and eating delicious damper!

All the teachers (including our Principal, Ms Smith!) were very impressed by our students' level of engagement and enthusiasm over the entire two days.

Our students had a fantastic camp and an abundance of new learning experiences.

YEAR TWO EXCURSION TO SCHOOLHOUSE MUSEUM

Recently, Year 2 Wombat, Emu and Cockatoos classes visited the NSW Schoolhouse Museum in Ryde to learn about the history of schools and how they have changed over time.

Two of our students, Lucy and William, wrote the following details about their time there.

"Outside, we did a range of activities. We did the maypole dance, a drill, fly, hoops, skipping and quoits. They were made out of natural materials like rope, wood and bamboo.

Next we went into the 1878 classroom and wrote with slate boards and pencils made from slate. We also used an inkwell and quill and learned about the cane! In the 1910s classroom, we toasted some bread on an open fire with golden syrup on top. We got an activity booklet and there were puzzles and games. We had lots of fun. We hope we can go there again."


BOOK WEEK AUTHOR VISIT - SAMI BAYLY








STAFF BIRTHDAY






