BOOK WEEK INCURSION NO.2: SPOKEN WORD POET

In Week 5, Years 3 to 6 were paid a visit by the formidable perfomer, **Zohab Zee Khan** - "Spoken Word Poet" - who is a rapper, slam poet, published poet and educator.

What a talented man he is! Zohab entertained our students for over an hour with a combination of slam poetry, rap, didgeridoo and harmonica playing, beat-boxing and percussion, along with his combination of audience participation and freestyle improvisation.

What made Zohab really inspiring were his words around self-development and multiculturalism. Growing up in rural NSW of Pakistani heritage, Zohab discussed his own experiences of social justice, in particular bullying, which were educational to everyone.

He delivered our students some powerful and inspiring messages on self-belief.



Students may wear mufti clothing on this day.










